

## National Workshop: An Overview of ICTs and Sustainable Development

2 May 2019, Phnom Penh hotel, Cambodia

Asian and Pacific Training Centre for ICT for Development's "Turning Today's Youth into Tomorrow's Leaders" programme aims to sensitize youth to the potential of ICT for promoting socio-economic development, and under this the Primer Series on ICTD for Youth (Primer Series) was created. The Primer Series aims to serve as a tool to help educators fill the gap in ICTD coverage in universities. It is composed of multiple issues addressing a range of topics in ICTD. This series is intended for students from both technical and non-technical backgrounds, and is flexible enough for use in different national contexts.

Since its launch in February 2012, the Primer Series has been rolled-out in 13 countries and introduced in 2 sub-regions. To further strengthen partners' institution adoption and utilization of the Primer Series in Cambodia, the workshop on An Overview of ICTS and Sustainable Development will provide an introduction and understanding of the interactions between ICTs and sustainable development. The workshop is designed to foster a multidisciplinary understanding of how ICTs can be used for social and economic development, and to equip students from different fields, from engineering to social sciences, with the skills needed to use ICTs to meet a country's development goals and needs. The workshop will also provide opportunity for participants for the exchange of knowledge and experiences from different institutions and universities.

### OBJECTIVES

The key objectives are to:

- Enhance understanding of the linkages between ICTs and sustainable development
- Increased adoption, utilization, and integration of ICTD education in university curricula through APCICT's Primer Series
- Provide a platform for the exchange of experiences among participants

### PARTICIPANTS

The training will be attended by – representatives of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sport, government, training institutions, universities, and other stakeholders.

The training will be held on **2 May 2019** in Cambodia and will consist of a series of lectures, and group discussions
