BACKGROUND

The Asian and Pacific Training Centre for ICT for Development (APCICT/ ESCAP) was established in June 2006 as a regional institute of the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) in Incheon, Republic of Korea. The mission of APCICT is to build the human and institutional capacity of the 62 ESCAP member and associate member States to use ICTs for sustainable development. To achieve its mission, APCICT delivers ICT human capacity building services through three distinct yet inter-related pillars of its work namely, training, knowledge sharing, and multi-stakeholder dialogue and partnership.

Since its inception, APCICT has designed and executed impactful ICT for development (ICTD) capacity building programmes to bridge the digital divide. The Centre's flagship training programme is the Academy of ICT Essentials for Government Leaders ('Academy'), which aims to impart training using Academy module curriculum to policymakers and government officials for leveraging the potential of ICTs for achieving national development goals. The Academy is utilized in 36 countries in Asia and the Pacific and various modules are available in 16 languages.

APCICT is updating an Academy Module on "ICT Project Management: Theory and Practice for Digital Transformation Project". The module objective is to introduce the identification, analysis, and application of various project management standards. The modules also aims to enable the project leader to recognize and use the internationally recognized standards and body of knowledge in managing a successful t digital transformation projects.

APCICT is convening a Virtual Review Meeting to solicit comments and feedback on the draft module on ICT Project Management: Theory and Practice for Digital Transformation Project. The objectives of the meeting are the following:

- Review the draft Academy Module on ICT Project Management: Theory and Practice for Digital Transformation Project to ensure its high quality, accessibility, and relevance to the target audience of project leaders and civil servants; and
- Exchange perspectives, experiences and lessons learned on effective ICT project management;

The meeting will be attended by about 10 experts and practitioners as well as representatives from ICT ministries and agencies, academia, and research organizations.
