## BACKGROUND

The “Academy of ICT Essentials for Government Leaders Programme” (Academy) is the flagship programme of the Asian and Pacific Training Centre for ICT for Development (APCICT/ESCAP) to equip government officials and policymakers with the essential knowledge and skills to leverage digital technologies for national and regional socio-economic development. Launched in 2008, the Academy’s comprehensive curriculum was developed in partnership with ICT experts as well as stakeholders from government, civil society and academia from countries in the region.
